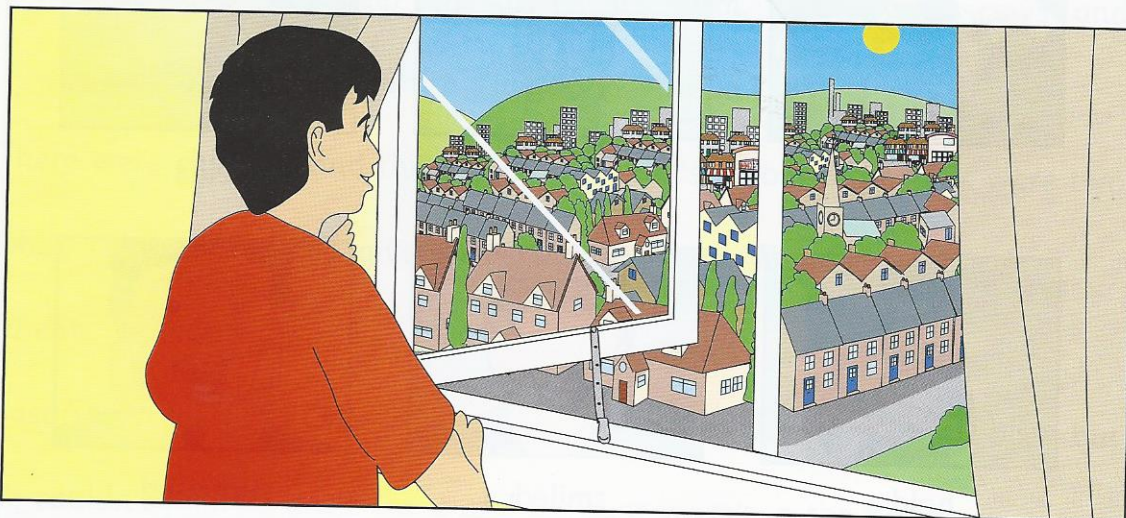

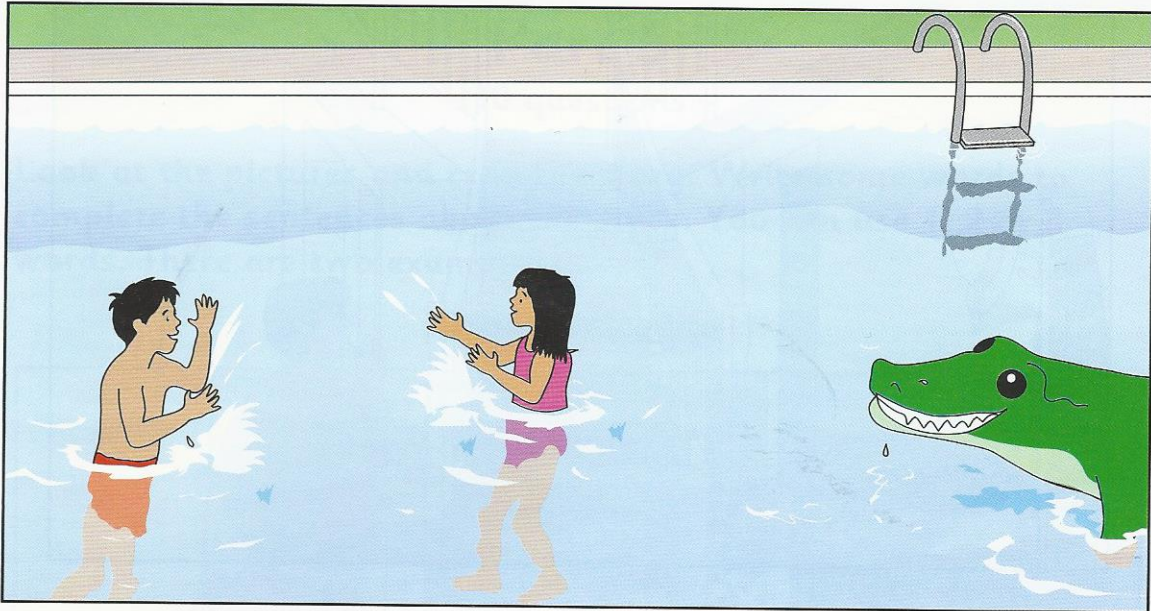
He walked to the door. It was open. Paul went and stood in the hall. He said loudly, "It's me! Paul!" But there was no answer.

"No!" said Sally. "Come on! We can both ride on its back!"

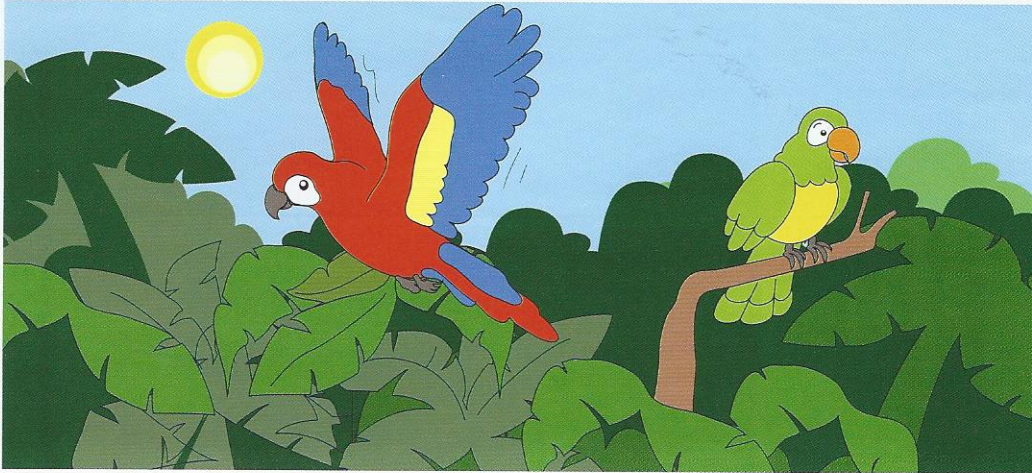
